### THE TOUCH INITIATIVE



Our ball

If you have been listening to the radio or watching television recently, you would have heard of The Touch Initiative which is sponsored by EnviroServ. The initiative was officially launched to EnviroServ staff on 1 September and it has since taken off. Orders for balls from staff, clients and members of the community have soared. Each ball creates employment and cleans up litter.

Touch is an initiative that touches communities by training unemployed seamstresses to make TOUCH rugby balls using recycled billboards. The balls are stuffed with between 25 and 30 plastic bags. This is a fun way of not only creating jobs, but cleaning up communities. Unemployed seamstresses receive extensive training on how to make these touch rugby balls. With this project, the ladies can earn as much as R200,00 a day for producing quality products which adhere to set measures. All those who purchase balls are guaranteed a quality product; the women have undergone extensive training and have been provided with the necessary equipment to ensure this.

This is a CSI initiative, and currently does not have the necessary resources to deal with the logistics required to deliver smaller orders. Please note that the project is not possible without suitable recycled materials and we would like to call on all companies to donate their banner material and plastics to the project.

A ball costs R50,00. The balls weigh around 1kg. Adults and children alike are able to play a game of touch rugby as evidenced by EnviroServ employees in their recent rugby challenge.
